As a Birmingham driver for Life On Wheels, I don't always get to see what happens on the bus. My role is mostly behind the scenes, getting the bus to the right location, setting it up, and then stepping back so the nurses and client advocates can do their work. But one day, something unforgettable happened.

We had just arrived at one of our regular sites. The bus wasn't even open yet when a woman knocked on the door. I stepped out to meet her, wondering if she needed help. But she didn't come for assistance, she came to say thank you. With a huge smile on her face, she proudly showed me her baby boy. I didn't know her name. I didn't know her story, whether she was scared, uncertain, or hopeful when she first stepped onto our bus. But what I did know in that moment was this: she had chosen life. And she had come back just to show me, the driver, her son. **She also stated, "Please keep doing what you're doing, and thank you all."**



It was one of the best moments I've ever experienced as a volunteer. That little boy and the joy radiating from his mother reminded me that every role matters. Even if we don't always see the impact, God is using all of us nurses, advocates, prayer warriors, and drivers alike, in powerful and eternal ways.

That child was living proof of the work that happens every day on that bus. And I'll never forget him.

My Story by Michelle

I thought I could be pregnant, but I wasn't sure. I didn't know what to do or where to go. I was overwhelmed by fear, uncertainty, and everything I was carrying in my heart. So I prayed. "God, I don't know how to do this. Please help me. Show me where to go." That's when I saw the Life On Wheels bus near the grocery store in Center Point. I knew right away—it wasn't a coincidence. It was God answering my prayer. I stepped onto the bus looking for answers. What I found was so much more. The women there didn't just give me a pregnancy test and an ultrasound—they welcomed me, listened to me, and let me cry. I shared my story... including the pain of losing my son.

That day, I found out I was pregnant with twins. I was already a mom, already grieving, already tired. I didn't know how I could do this with two. But God wasn't done. Before I left, I received many resources, and they referred me to a church. Alison, the nurse, told me, "I want you to meet Leria." The next day, I got a call that changed everything. Leria became a lifeline. She saw me, not just as a client, but as a woman with value and a story. Through her, I found a church, a community, and the support I had been praying for. When I heard those two heartbeats at my first OB appointment, I felt something I hadn't felt in a long time: hope. After losing my son, I never thought I'd feel joy again. But I knew in that moment, God was restoring what I thought was lost.

It's still hard, but I'm not walking through it alone anymore. The women on the bus, Leria, and the Guiding Light Church, now my family, carried me through my hardest season. I was adopted. My whole life, I longed for a family that would stay. That love without conditions. And now, for the first time, I feel like that dream is coming true.

God found me in a parking lot in Center Point. He used Life On Wheels. He used Leria. He used my brokenness to begin something beautiful.

If you're where I was - scared and unsure- please hear this: **God sees you.** He hears your prayers. And He knows exactly where to find you.


